

What to Bring/Not to Bring

There are several items that guests are not allowed to bring into the Interim House. A comprehensive list of what to bring and not to bring is outlined below. We have no availability to store items that are not allowed in the Interim House. **You are responsible for separating your things and having your personal items stored elsewhere before your arrival at the Interim House. Again, we do not have the time or space to do this during or after the intake process.** The total volume of your belongings may not exceed what you can fit inside two plastic totes (issued at intake).

Have Mercy is not responsible for any valuables or belongings that are lost or stolen.

These items would be helpful for you to **BRING** with you upon admission:

- Photo ID, Birth Certificate, Social Security Card, Health Insurance Card, EBT Card
- Important phone numbers
- Prescribed Medications
- Clothing
- Pillow
- Cell Phone, Portable Laptop
- Hygiene products, but if needed, we will supply products to meet basic hygiene needs
- Bible (one reading book allowed)
- Coloring Book/Pencils
- Food (small refrigerator in which you will share with your roommate)
- The total volume of your belongings may not exceed what you can fit inside two plastic totes (2 per person/issued at intake).

These items are not permitted. Please **DO NOT BRING** them:

- T.V's, Desk Computers, Coffee Makers, DVR's, Electronics
- Knick-Knacks,
- Paintings, Jewelry Boxes
- Furniture, Lamps
- Blankets, Sheets, Bedding, Towels,
- Dishes, Pots and Pans
- Weapons
- Pocket Knives
- Tools
- Illegal Drugs, Alcohol, Drug Paraphernalia
- Knitting Needles, Crochet Hooks, Yarn

The following items will be **PROVIDED** at intake:

- Two Totes
- Locker (Storage for prescription medications and valuables)
- Room Key, Locker Key and Front Door Code
- Blankets
- Sheets
- Pillow (you can take with you when leaving the program)
- Towels/washcloths
- Basic Personal Hygiene Products
- Laundry Bag
